

Dear Director Furcolo, Director Aubin, and Associate Director Toro;

TRMG, TRWH, UTGR AND PE II (collectively “Twin River”) hereby waive and release any right(s) they may otherwise assert that they may have against the State of Rhode Island, the Rhode Island Division of Lotteries and/or the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation arising as a result of the Lottery’s directive via letter March 13, 2020 to Mr. Craig Sculos requiring the closure of the gaming facilities located in Lincoln and Tiverton Rhode Island (copy of letter attached). Said waiver and release relates to all causes of action whether sounding in contract, tort or otherwise.

The State of Rhode Island/DOR and/or the Division of Lotteries and/or the Department of Business Regulation (collectively “the State”) hereby waive and release any right that they may otherwise assert against Twin River for claims of breach or non-compliance of the agreements between Twin River and the State related to or arising from the closure during the period of closure and the reporting period within the closure period.

Via letter dated March 19, 2020, the director of the Lottery directed that the gaming facilities continued to be closed until further directive from the Lottery. The waivers and releases referenced above (which are in addition to and an extension of the waivers and releases referenced in a letter date March 14, 2020) will continue in effect during any period where the gaming facilities are closed pursuant to this or any future directives of the director of the Rhode Island Lottery.




